Registration is now OPEN. Please, please, please register by **Wednesday, February 5**, so we know exactly who is in the cast as so much of the preparation depends on this. Here's how you do it:

- 1. Go to the Canmore Skating Club Uplifter website <u>https://canmoresc.uplifterinc.com/</u>
- 2. LOGIN using your email address and password (click on "LOGIN" in upper right corner, enter your login information, click on "LOGIN" button)
- 3. Click on "SHOPPING CART" (also in upper right corner)
- 4. Click on "Purchase Products" box
- 5. Enter the number of skaters you are registering for the show in the "QTY" box then click on "ADD" button.
- 6. Enter the names of the skater(s); their Age, Clothing Size and Measurements (Chest, Waist, Hips, Height in inches) in the text box provided.
